Few words about





Vision conceived by the European Commission in 2015, officially launched in 2018.

Initiative to create an infrastructure providing its users with services promoting <u>open science</u> practices.

Researchers, innovators, companies and citizens can publish, find and reuse data, tools and services for research, innovation and educational purposes.

What is RoLECT?

- Self-assessment tool against EOSC RoP focusing on Legal & Ethics aspects.
- Designed to promote compliance with the key legal and ethical aspects of EOSC RoP
- Understand the main priorities of EOSC RoP.
- Version released: 1.1, July 2021.

Development approach




Guidelines of EOSC Executive Board RoP Working Group

Deconstruct EOSC RoP into general categories (transparency, legal aspects, ethics) Reconstruct units of rules & classification according to priorities of EOSC RoP Structured flow of questions categorized into three levels of importance

Legal and ethics aspects

- Intellectual Property Rights: verification that no intellectual property rights of third parties are infringed.
- Licensing conditions related to IPR (i.e. open licenses, standard licenses, machine readable licenses).
- License compatibility assessment when two or more different open licenses apply (Check lct.ni4os.eu).
- **Public domain**: the provider has to indicate if the resource is in the public domain and thus it can be used.
- Other restrictions: resource falling into the scope of cultural heritage law.
- **Personal Data**: minimum level of compliance with GDPR → lawfulness of processing (Art 6§4 GDPR), information obligation (Art. 13, 14 GDPR), and data subjects' rights (Art. 15-22 GDPR).

Legal and ethics aspects



 Conditions that may allow (Public Sector Information) or restrict the use of the resource (i.e. trade secrets, confidential information).







Scenario

Assume that you have a research product (data set) that you wish to onboard within the EOSC Portfolio, but you are not sure if your data set meets the basic EOSC RoP requirements.

Challenges faced

- EOSC RoP do not provide for specific compliance criteria ("high-level" information);
- Lack of sufficient knowledge and understanding of Legal and Ethics aspects of RoP.
- No similar tools available.





What are the risks?


- The resource may be licensed under a non- compatible with EOSC RoP license;
- Existence of data that cannot be further used in the EOSC ecosystem.
